



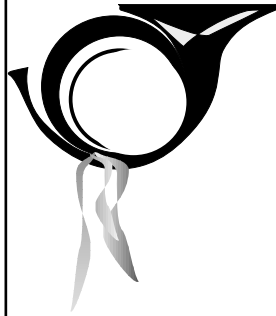

• HACCP Overview

HACCP Overview:

HACCP stands for Hazard Analysis & Critical Control Points. This overview is designed to help the individual become familiar with the HACCP concepts of risk management, to identify critical control points, and to assist in developing corrective and preventive action programs. This program is mandatory for seafood processing plants and is now recommended as an adjunct to medical device companies. The next step is for pharmaceutical implementation. The medical and pharmaceutical implementation of HACCP is voluntary, but highly recommended. The progressive company is always looking at preventive action systems and this is one technique that is time tested and proven to prevent problems at the source.
